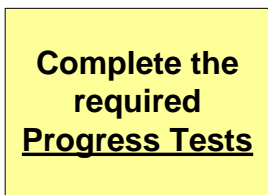


# What do I need to do in order to sit for my final exam?

## Step 1



<u>Subject</u>	<u>Progress tests required</u>
Introductory math	10 out of 10
Senior math	10 out of 10
Chemistry	11 out of 11
Physics	9 out of 9
Biology	18 out of 26

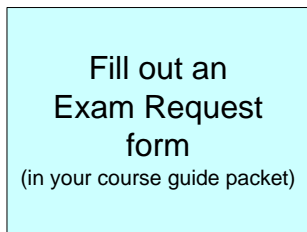
You will need to pass each exam with a 60% or better to be eligible to sit an exam

You should submit your specimen exam at the same time as your exam request form.



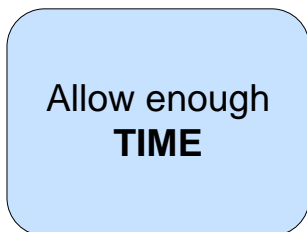
You **MUST** complete the required number of Progress Tests first

## Step 2



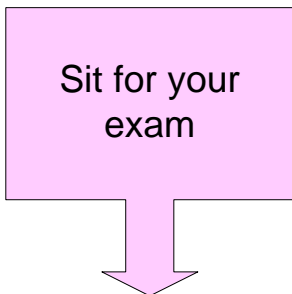
If you plan on sitting for your exam at an LNQ centre please indicate which one. You will need to arrange for a time and day when tests are already scheduled or when the centre is open.

If you are having someone else (teacher, lecturer) supervise your exam please provide us with a few test dates that your nominated supervisor agrees to. The exam **MUST** be sat at a business.



Allow **10 working days** for your exam to be processed, the nominated supervisor contacted, and the exam mailed.

## Step 3



<u>Subject</u>	<u>Exam time required</u>
Introductory math	3 hours + 15 minutes perusal
Senior math	2 tests each (2 hours + 15 minutes perusal)
Chemistry	3 hours + 10 minutes perusal
Physics	3 hours + 10 minutes perusal
Biology	3 hours + 15 minutes perusal
